Please send a PDF of high quality work composed to be printed on 30"x42" board (portrait orientation).

Please submit one project per board.

Application fee is \$30 per board, payable to AIA San Antonio.

Multiple boards can be submitted - max. 3 boards per individual.

Work can consist of:

Architecture: completed projects, competition efforts (e.g. photos of models, renderings)

Media considered an extension of architecture: art, graphic design, etc.

Please submit a 100 word max. description of your project (as a Microsoft Word Document) and include: collaborators (if applicable), year of completion (if applicable), location of project.

**PHOTO**

Please submit a photo of the designer(s). Photo must be a JPEG, 3" x 3", 300dpi.
