The San Antonio Report, which first published in February 2012, is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit, nonpartisan local news organization. We are San Antonio's leading local online news source focusing on the personalities, politics, neighborhoods, businesses, culture, cuisine, arts and entertainment that impact San Antonio.

**POSITION OVERVIEW**

The Shiner Editorial Intern will have the opportunity to observe our news reporters, photographers, and editors at work, understand the workflow of our digital newsroom, and shadow staff members as they report on stories. The intern also will get the opportunity to produce news stories and features under the guidance of our staff.



Generously underwritten by The Impetus Foundation, the Shiner Internship program for St. Mary's University students is comprised of two internship opportunities for summer 2021: one editorial intern and one business team intern. Shiner Interns will be mentored by San Antonio Report leadership and provided educational opportunities to learn from both editorial and business staff. Shiner Editorial Interns will be provided opportunities to attend three separate virtual meetings or lunches with business and civic leaders over the course of the internship.

### **QUALIFICATIONS**

A successful editorial intern will be a curious self-starter who is eager to seek out stories in the San Antonio community that will resonate with our readers. The ideal candidate will have excellent writing skills, some experience reporting and writing on deadline, the ability to jump on breaking news stories when they happen, and a knack for spotting engaging feature stories. The intern will need to be familiar with AP style and Wordpress and be willing to work nights and weekends when asked. The ideal candidate will have a strong interest in San Antonio and independent, nonprofit journalism.

Fluency in Spanish is a plus, and preference will be given to applicants who have writing, reporting, or editing experience with the university's newspaper, The Rattler.
