We bring to your attention a matter of urgency regarding the performance of our City Attorney, Andrew Segovia, and to request an immediate meeting to advise you with respect to his fitness to continue serving in that position.

Despite the City Council's clear and repeated requests on key issues, it has become evident that the City Attorney has consistently failed to follow through. Additionally, there have been significant inconsistencies and a demonstrated lack of transparency in his legal opinions which have caused delays and unpredictability which affect the Council's ability to make timely and well-informed plans and decisions.


