SUBJECT: Plan of action for crosswalks located at N. Main Ave. and E. Evergreen St. in San Antonio, Texas

Mr. Villarreal:

The City of San Antonio (the "City") received your letter dated November 25, 2025, stating that it did not consider the City's request for an exemption from TxDOT's mandate to remove the rainbow-colored crosswalks at the intersection of N. Main Ave. and E. Evergreen St. to be acceptable. The City continues to believe that the crosswalks in question are safer than before the installation of the rainbow-colored paint, that the intersection is safer than comparable nearby intersections, and that it demonstrated the importance of the crosswalks to the Pride Cultural Heritage District. Nevertheless, the City will respect TxDOT's decision.

This letter is to comply with TxDOT's request to provide an action plan for the removal of the crosswalks. Within the next few days, the City plans to begin engaging with potential contractors to remove the existing crosswalks and install standard crosswalk markings. During that time, the City will also identify available funds to perform the work. The City will complete removal and replacement operations on or before January 15, 2026.
