**Subject:** Noncompliance With Texas Education Code § 37.082 and Missed Corrective Action Plan Deadline

Superintendent Jarrett and Board President Beyer:

This letter serves as formal notice regarding North East Independent School District's (NEISD) failure to meet both statutory and agency-directed requirements pertaining to the corrective action ordered by the Texas Education Agency (TEA) on November 6, 2025.

NEISD's noncompliance with state law, Tex. Educ. Code § 37.082 (Student Use of Personal Communication Devices), includes:

- the failure to adopt district policy to comply with state law as previously outlined by TEA; and
- the failure to complete required correctives actions and pass a compliant board policy by the directed deadline.

As a result, NEISD is in violation of both state law and the directed Corrective Action Plan (CAP).

Under the statutorily required process, TEA will issue a preliminary report to the district outlining the agency's legal findings. NEISD will then have 30 days to respond following receipt of that report. Following NEISD's response to the preliminary report, and consistent with the agency's statutory authority, TEA may impose sanctions, which may include but are not limited to the appointment of a conservator to oversee district operations or the appointment of a board of managers to govern the district.

In short, NEISD had an opportunity to correct course and comply with state law but has refused to do so; therefore, the formal process will proceed. If the district has additional information it wishes TEA to consider, NEISD may provide such information in its written response following issuance of the preliminary report.
