



EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR, CAST SCHOOLS

Jeanne is the founding Executive Director of the Centers for Applied Science and Technology, commonly known as CAST Schools, a network of innovative, career-connected, partnership schools.



Jeanne started her career as a teacher, later tackled educational challenges as an award-winning investigative reporter, and then moved to the public sector to contribute to solving the very concerns she had spotlighted as a journalist. She left city government to help found SA2020, the nonprofit, and later co-founded a consulting practice where she helped design multiple initiatives catalyzing regional economic mobility. Jeanne has been the primary architect of signature San Antonio education initiatives.
