

RESOLUTION

Declining to Adopt a Policy Under SB 11 Regarding a Period of Prayer and Reading of Religious Texts

WHEREAS, SB 11 (89th Legislature) authorizes the Board of Trustees to adopt a local policy requiring each campus to provide students and employees with an opportunity to participate in a daily period of prayer and reading of the Bible or other religious texts; and

WHEREAS, SB 11 does not require school districts to adopt such a policy, and adoption remains solely at the discretion of each local Board of Trustees; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees acknowledges and supports the rights of students to engage in voluntary, student-initiated, non-disruptive religious expression, including prayer, in accordance with state and federal law, including Texas Education Code §25.151, §25.901, and the First Amendment to the United States Constitution; and

WHEREAS, the Board continues to support AHISD current practices of a daily moment of silence whereby students and staff have the opportunity for prayer or reflection ; and

WHEREAS, after consideration of the statutory option provided by SB 11, the Board finds that adopting a policy establishing a school-directed period of prayer and reading of religious texts is not necessary;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

2. The Board affirms current AHISD practices of a daily moment of silence whereby students and staff have the opportunity for prayer or reflection.






