SUMMARY:

Submitted for City Council consideration and action is a proposal submitted by OES-USA, Inc., to provide a centerhung system, installation labor, commissioning, removal of current equipment, on-site training and live production event support at the Alamodome for the Convention and Sports Facilities Department (CSF). The new centerhung system will include stadium light-emitting diode (LED) scoreboard, arena LED scoreboard, arena underbelly LED scoreboard, scoreboard lighting, Ross Xpression upgrades and video systems, LED video scoreboards, and a display control system manufactured by Novastar (Video System).

The new centerhung systems will provide a center stadium light-emitting diode (LED) scoreboard and an arena LED scoreboard. The scoreboards will be an integral part of the National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA) Woman's Final Four Volleyball Championship to be held in the Alamodome in December 2026. Also, part of the centerhung system is an arena underbelly LED scoreboard which is compatible with the new arena LED scoreboard. The scoreboard lighting will consist of a package containing 12 new moving lights that will be attached to the center stadium

LED scoreboard. The Ross Xpression upgrades and video systems consist of several working parts which allow the creation of 3D real-time graphics and playback video clips on video screens and LED scoreboards. A display control system manufactured by Novastar (Video System) will provide signals for the new LED video scoreboards. The new system will consist of a processor and video cards that will work in conjunction with Ross products.

The current centerhung scoreboard does not have any replacement parts and/or service available for the existing video board which was purchased in October of 2019. Presently when a video screen and scoreboard is needed in the northern part of the Alamodome, CSF must dismantle the existing center-hung video screen and move it to the required location causing excessive wear and tear and damage to the centerhung scoreboard.

The City issued Request for Offer (RFO) for “Centerhung Systems for Alamodome” on April 16, 2026, with a submission deadline of April 28, 2026. An email notification was released to three (3) potential cooperative respondents. Three (3) offers were received, and OES-USA, Inc. is the lowest responsive offer meeting all published specifications and is recommended for award.

This purchase is made in accordance with the National Intergovernmental Purchasing Alliance Company (Omnia Partners) Program approved through Ordinance 2013-06-13-1414, dated 06/13/2013. These centerhung systems will be purchased from OES-USA, Inc., utilizing the Omnia Partners Cooperative contract number 08-37 Scoreboards and Electronic Signage Region 14 Education Service Center (ESC)-TX. The use of the cooperative contract allows CSF to purchase and install centerhung scoreboard system(s) to ensure uninterrupted audio and visual operation of live events at the Alamodome. OES-USA, Inc. will deliver and install the centerhung system by September 4, 2026, the start of the University of Texas at San Antonio (UTSA) football season. The term of the contract will be upon award by City Council and will terminate upon delivery and installation of all goods ordered.

The Small Business Economic Development Advocacy (SBEDA) Ordinance was not applicable to provide these services.

The Local Preference Program does not apply to construction service contracts of \$100,000 or more, so no preference was applied to this contract. The Veteran-Owned Small Business Preference Program does not apply to construction service contracts, so no preference was applied to this contract.

The vendor has acknowledged to comply with the Heat Illness Prevention Ordinance, approved on August 31, 2023, through Ordinance #2023-08-31-0585.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This ordinance authorizes a contract with OES-USA, Inc., to provide a centerhung system, installation labor, commissioning, removal of current equipment, on-site training and live production event support at the Alamodome for the Convention and Sports Facilities Department (CSF), in an amount not to exceed \$2,325,892. Funding is available from the Alamodome Improvement and Contingency Fund and will be appropriated into the project upon approval.
